While this letter is required, its contents will not be considered as part of the LOI review process.

As detailed in the RFP, **only one applicant from a university or non-profit research institute will be considered in each application cycle.** For purposes of this policy, the Foundation considers the parent university to be the relevant institution. Accordingly, a university with a law school, medical school, several teaching hospitals, and a faculty of arts and sciences may only submit one letter of intent in total. If a university system, such as a state-wide university system, comprises several universities, each university within the system may nominate one applicant.
